



## Facility Use Guidelines

Lake Nixon is a place for recreation, education, and sanctuary for all. Facility guests help maintain this mission by following these guidelines:

Lake Nixon facilities must be left in the same manner they were found:

- We encourage everyone to place aluminum cans and clear plastic water bottles in the yellow and green recycling receptacles. **\*\*Please ensure that guests do not put food or other non-recyclable waste in the recycling.\*\***
- Rental groups are responsible for any missing, stolen or damaged property.
- Before leaving, Lake Nixon building and grounds are to be cleaned in accordance with these instructions:
  - Pavilions, bathrooms, beaches, general grounds: please dispose of all trash in receptacles and take to dumpster across the street.
  - Boats: hang life jackets and paddles and make sure all watercraft are secured to docks
  - Tables, chairs or other equipment are to be put away as they were found.
- Pets are not allowed on the Lake Nixon property unless approved in advance. All pets must remain leashed and all waste picked up and disposed of.
- Youth & children are to be supervised at all times.
- *There will be no use of alcohol or non-prescription drugs.*
- Open fires are not permitted without express permission & *smoking is not allowed.*
- *Beach-front certified Lifeguards are required to be able to use the waterfront for swimming.* An additional fee will be charged to provide lifeguards.
- Beach-front rules are posted in front of the beaches
- Boat and board rules are posted next to the docks and canoe landing. *All riders must wear a life jacket.* Adult supervision is required for use of boats/boards.
- No swimming or boating after dark.
- Fishing is catch-and-release.
- In case of medical emergency
  - A First Aid kit is located in the basket house between the bathrooms.
  - An AED Device is available on site
  - Nearest Emergency Room is Baptist Hospital
